

PACHTHOF, SO-CALLED CASTLE. History. The prehistory coincides with the castle property of the same property (see above.) The oldest parts of the farm belong to 111 of the 17th century. Friedrich Caspar von Bibra has been visiting Hochheim since 1708 (see page 44). Under him, in any case, the manor house was built, which then Karl von Bibra (REINHART) FHR V BIBRA, MS PAGE 12, 1762 et seq., - see below.)

Description. East of the village, on the Strafie to Rothausen. The manor is located on the Strafie, behind, grouped around an Okonomiehof, the farm building. The manor house is a simple two-storey complex of 11 : 5 window axes with factory floor and hipped roof. Rusticated Ecklisenen. Brick driveway, liber the archway marriage coat of *arms Bibra-Utten-hoven, and date* iy6g. (To Charles of Bibra, who came in 1769 in full possession of the estate, and whose Gcmahlin, née von Uttenhofen, referred. See REINHARD FHR of BIBRA, MS page 12.)
