

Aroldshausen, manor and district, 13 km south-south-east of Meiningen, belonged to the Bibra manor since ancient times. In 1736 it came to the Brennhausen side line, in 1767 back to the main Bibra line of the baronial family; In 1796 Jos. Hartmann v. Bibra of the Hochheim line sold. The estate is still owned by the barons v. Bibra.
